Since 2011, our public Spay & Neuter Clinic in South Lansing has provided critical low-cost services, but growing demand has exceeded our facility's capacity. Surgeries are often booked four months out, leaving many pets and their owners waiting.

Thanks to a generous building donation from the Michael G. Eyde Estate, we now have the opportunity to expand at a new location—3303 West Saginaw Street in Lansing. This move will allow us to dramatically increase the number of lifesaving procedures we provide.

To make this vision a reality, we must quickly raise \$1.5 million for renovations. Your support will help create a fully equipped, high-capacity clinic to better serve our community.

OUR VISION

- Enable us to accommodate more animals for spaying and neutering procedures.
- Reduce wait times.
- Establish two surgery suites capable of accommodating two surgeons and allow us to double our capacity, reducing the number of stray animals and alleviating the burden on animal shelters and rescue organizations.
- Reach a larger geographic area and serve a broader population of pet owners. This is particularly important in regions such as Clinton, Eaton, and Ingham counties, where access to affordable spay and neuter services is limited.
